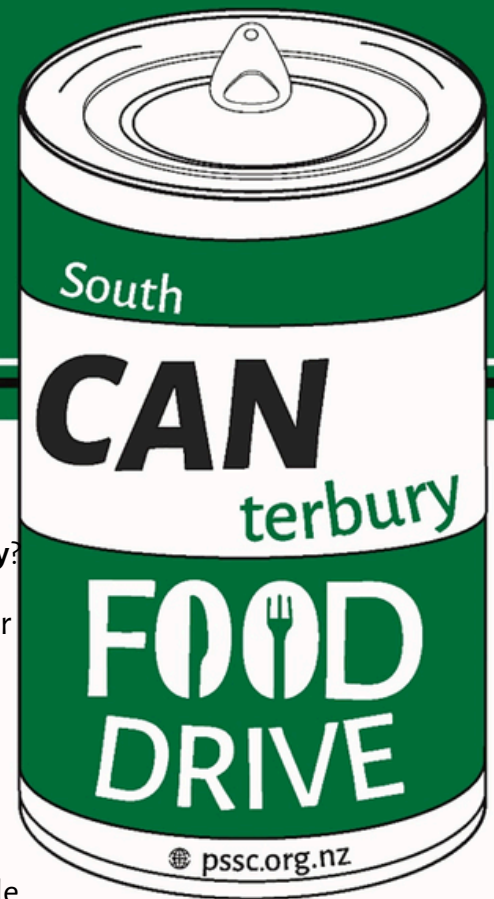




Kia ora to your School/ECE, Business or Group of Friends

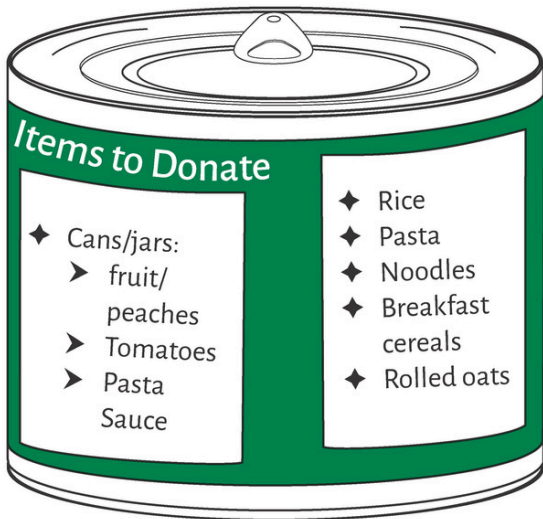

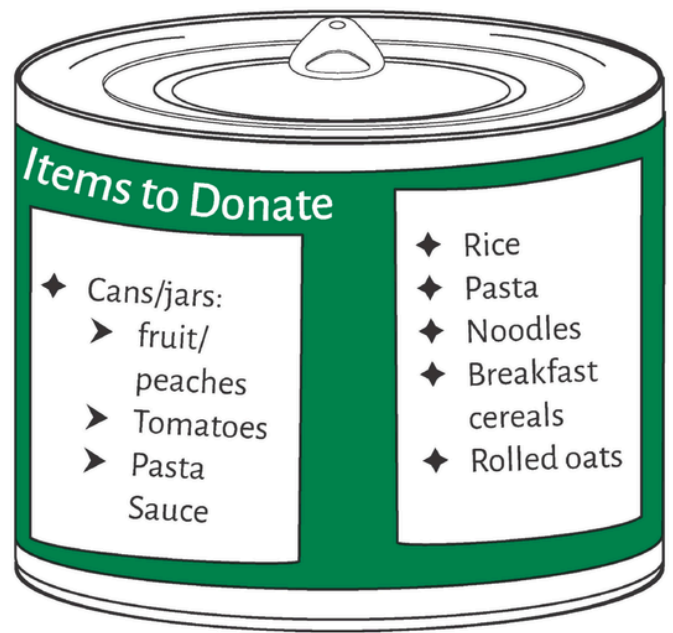
