The Aims

Big Buddies are

- Adults who are there to listen, support and encourage their Little Buddy
- · People to hang out and have fun with once a week for 2-3 hours
- · Adults aged 18 years and over
- · Women and Men from varied backgrounds and life experiences
- Adult role models who can provide a healthy adult/child relationship



Little Buddies are

- · Primary school aged children up to 12 years old
- Children whose life circumstances indicate the need for additional adult support
- Children who need extra help coping with or fitting into their home, school or community
- Referred from a variety of sources, such as social workers, public health nurses, teachers and by their own family
