Mission:

PSSC is constituted for exclusively charitable purposes and shall not carry out any objects except to support people with quality care and Christian love and any other charitable object which may seem to the Board capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above or calculated directly or indirectly to advance the said objects, including the distribution of surplus funds to any other body which is itself a charitable body registered with the Department of Internal Affairs – Charities.

Objects:

The Objects of PSSC are, within the Region of South Canterbury, to:

- > Establish and maintain social services that promote the welfare of people in need of support;
- Establish and maintain appropriate residential facilities and community based services for people in need of support.
- > Co-operate with other social service and church agencies carrying on work of a similar nature as that carried on by PSSC;
- Advance such other social service work as may benefit the people of South Canterbury;
- Advance all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above purposes.
